INTRODUCTION

The members of the Arizona America250 Commission sought to designate mission and vision statements as well as a set of values for the purposes of public programming, clarity, and alignment for philanthropic giving. Discussions were held across several meetings to identify the principles and statements that will guide the Commission's Semiquincentennial efforts.

MISSION

The Arizona America 250 commission is established to plan, develop, encourage and coordinate the commemoration of the two hundred fiftieth anniversary of the founding of the United States and the impact of the citizens of this state on the nation's past, present, and future.

VISION

To illuminate Arizona's untamed spirit of independence, the 250th celebration will serve as the cornerstone for a statewide commemoration that uplifts the voices of all Arizonans, drives innovation, preserves history, and forges lasting connections. Together, we will tell our state's story.



VALUES

The Commission chose the acronym "RISE" to evoke an Arizona sunrise.

Respect: Honoring the diverse cultures and complex historical perspectives that have shaped Arizona.

Inclusive Collaboration: Ensuring all Arizonans feel represented and valued in the commemoration, and that challenges and resiliency are recognized.

Stewardship and Service: Protecting and preserving Arizona's natural, architectural, historic, and cultural landscape.

Education: Empowering current and future generations through historical understanding, preservation, civic engagement, and a vision for the future.

As the Commission undertakes America250 planning, guiding values to evaluate public programming can be summarized into a single sentence:

Upcoming events

Two Lights for Tomorrow, April 18, 2025



America250 AZ's kickoff will be held on the 250th anniversary of Paul Revere's ride. Held at the Arizona State Capitol, this public event will feature historical reenactments, a color guard, speeches from notable Arizonans, food trucks, a free concert, a possible F-16 and Stratotanker flyover, and more. The event will culminate in the lighting of two spotlights atop the State House and the State Senate.

Estimated budget: \$150,000 - \$180,000

Traveling Museum + Liberty Bell Send-off, Spring/Summer 2026



Notable pieces of Arizona history, including our replica Liberty Bell, will be toured across the state. While the bell is gone, a new ceremonial base will be installed. The base will include both a 50-year and 100-year time capsule.

Estimated budget: \$1.5-2 million

ASU Gammage Event, Fall 2025/Spring 2026



This event will feature a VIP reception and a performance highlighting a notable chapter in American History.

Estimated budget: \$50,000

Closing Event, Summer 2026



The Semiquincentennial will be brought to a close in style with a marquee concert and fireworks event.

Estimated budget: \$50,000 - \$100,000
